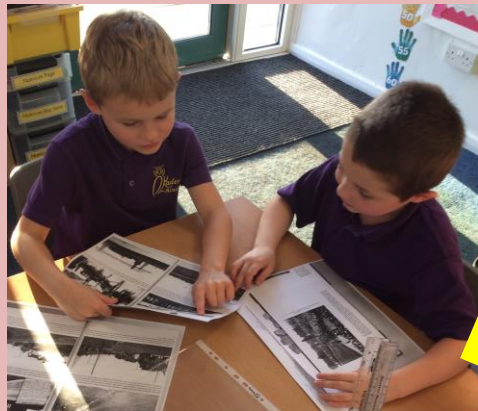
Reception
