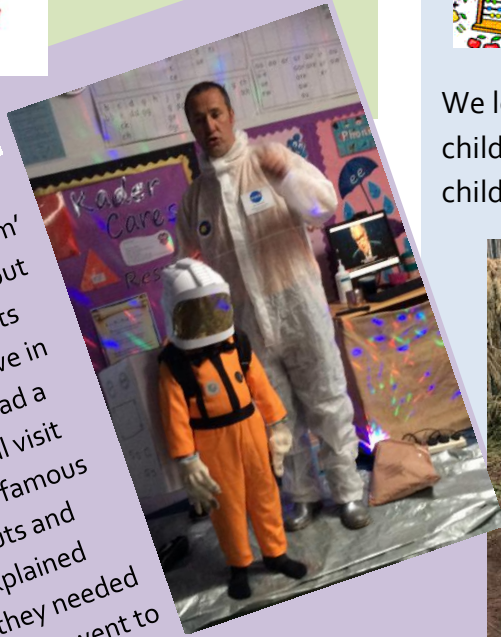
Mr Lavenick's keep fit task..

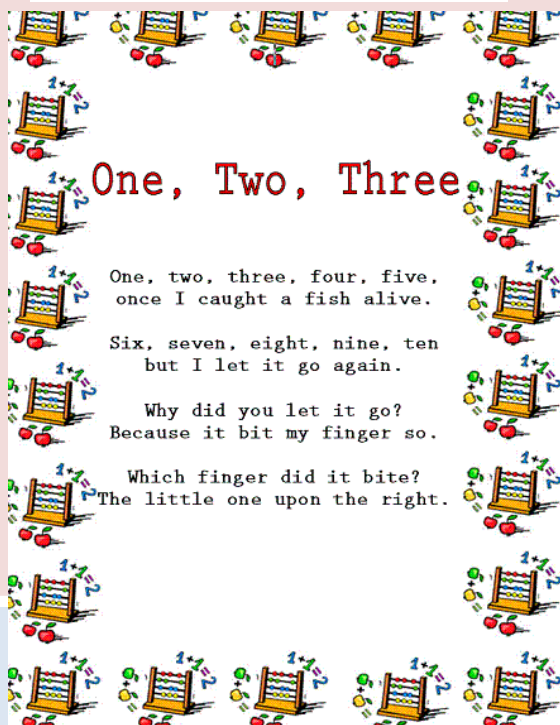


Year 5

We love digging in Nursery! Remember our motto ... A muddy child is a happy child! We utilise our outdoor area and the children love it!



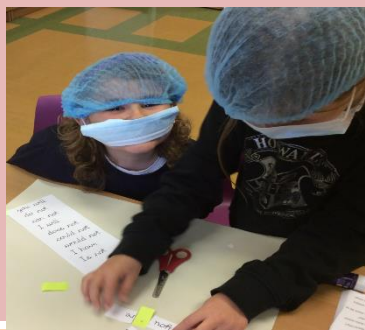
Reception
