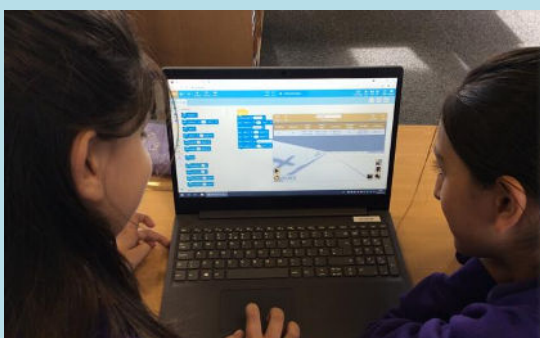


Year 4
