## Year 5

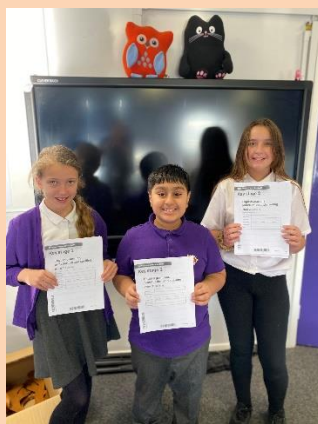
We have had a lovely week in Year 5! The children have been learning all about the phases of the moon in Science and have recreated the lunar cycle with Oreo biscuits!
